Meeting Minutes from last month:

Treasurer:

- 67,072.64 is what is in our account as of today.
- 4998.48 of that are from PayPal
- 500 scholarship check wrote out to Aaron Hampton
- \$250 for former NKYFL kid Brock GoFundMe
- \$80.00 Storage
- \$45.57 Rope

Football:
