
TME CHEER CLINICS

2025 FOOTBALL FUNDAMENTALS CAMP

LOCATION

Camps are located on the beautiful Thomas More University campus in Crestview Hills, Ky., with easy access off I-275 (Exit 82, Turkeyfoot Rd.). All instruction and games are held at the Republic Bank Field.

COST
